

DETERMINATION OF FINANCIAL AID FOR A STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

Students that are interested in enrolling in a Study Abroad Program may be eligible to use financial aid to assist in paying for Study Abroad costs. In order to utilize financial aid students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have financial aid eligibility for the semester in which they plan to enroll. Students should be prepared to cover expenses that cannot be covered by financial aid due to a lack of funds or disbursement date.

If you are a financial aid recipient and you have received more financial aid than your Harper College student account charges, you will receive a refund. You should expect to receive this refund approximately 14 days after the financial aid has been disbursed to your account.

1. Complete the FAFSA and other documentation, if any, requested from the Office of Financial Assistance.
2. Meet with a Student Development (Study Abroad Counselor) to complete the section below. Attach the Study Abroad Schedule for the program you want to attend.
3. Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor. You must bring your Study Abroad Budget for the program you want to attend.
4. Complete the Summer Financial Aid Application if your program of interest is during the summer semester.
5. Submit the Determination of Financial Aid for a Study Abroad Program form to the counselor.
