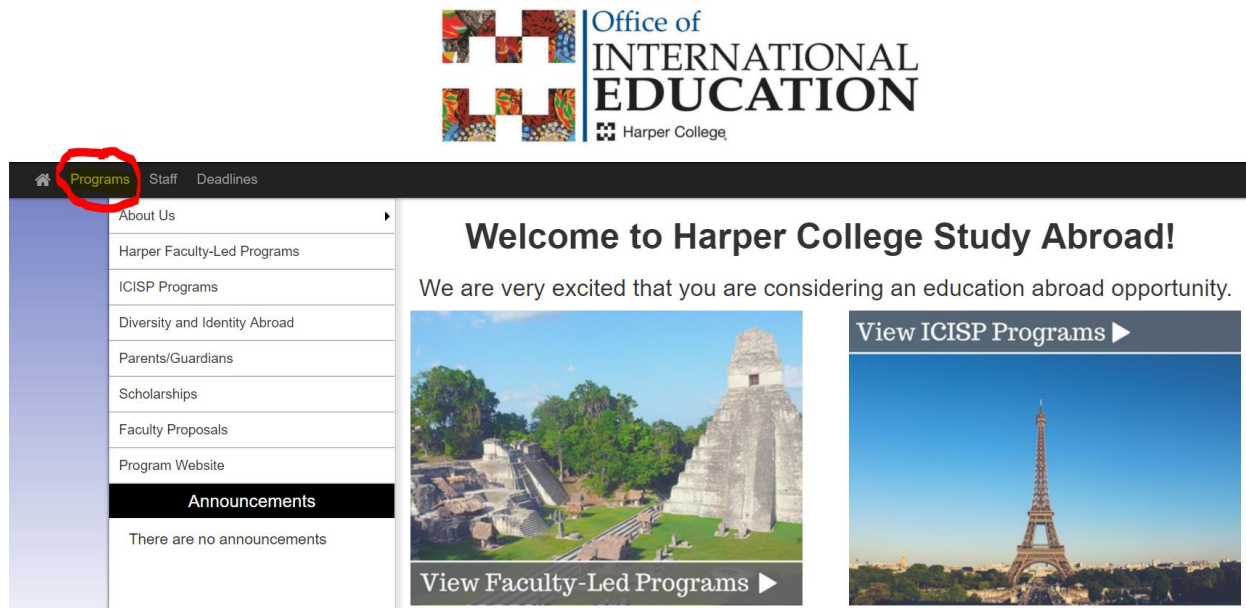
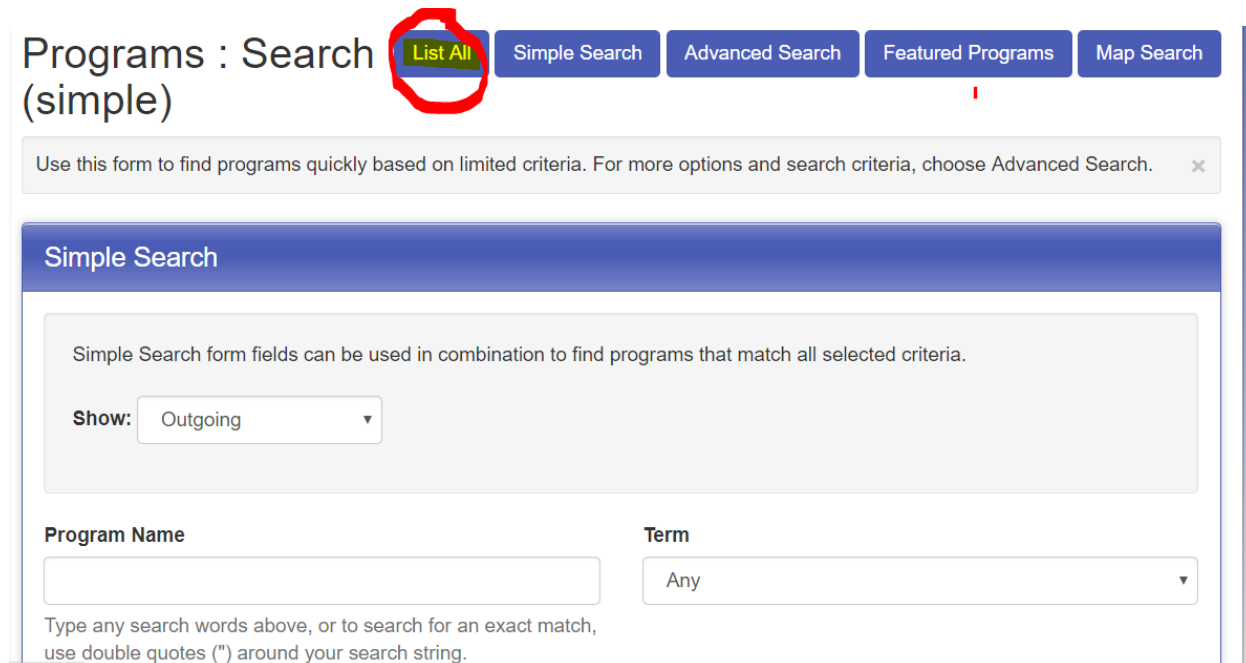


# How to Get Started using the Harper College Study Abroad Terra Dotta application system

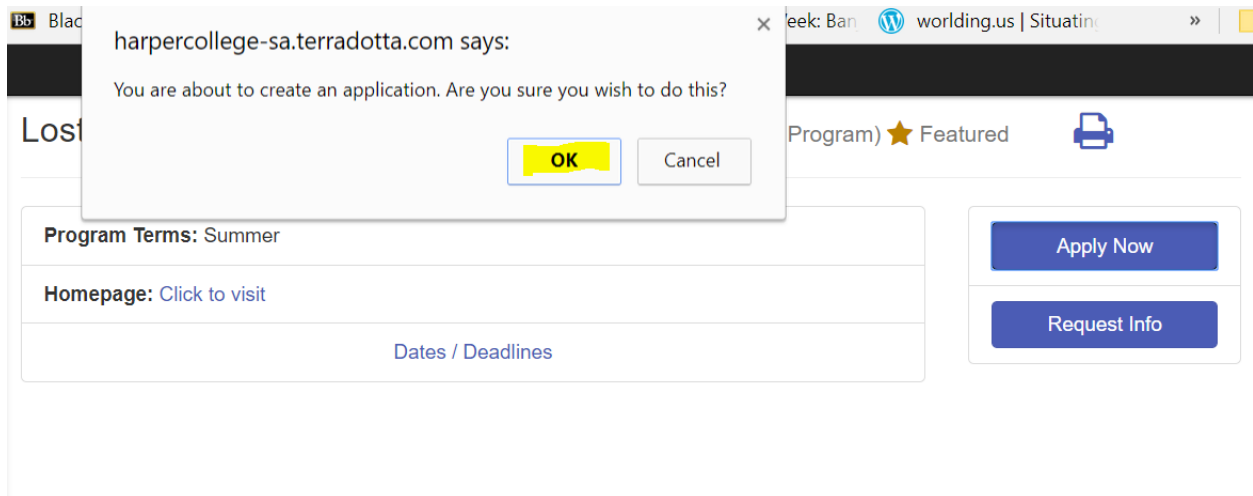
